No. F-9(16)/RG/UERC/2009/ 1116 In exercise of powers conferred under section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, and after previous publication, the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following regulations to amend the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (The Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2007 read with the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (The Electricity Supply Code) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2008 the (Principal Regulations), namely:

1. Short Title, Commencement and Interpretation

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (The Electricity Supply Code) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2009.
- (2) These Regulations extend to the whole of the State of Uttarakhand.
- (3) These shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. In Sub-Regulation 5.2.3 of the Principal Regulation:

After clause (4), the following shall be inserted, namely:-

“Provided that, where it is established that there is a case of Unauthorised Usage of electricity by way of usage of electricity for the purpose other than for which the usage of electricity was authorised, the licensee shall for the purpose of preparing the assessment bill take into consideration the actual amount of consumption recorded by the correct meter for the entire period during which such unauthorised use of electricity has taken place, and where such period cannot be ascertained, such period shall be limited to a period of twelve months immediately preceding the date of inspection. The above energy consumption shall be considered only in case if metering system is healthy, else the energy consumption shall be calculated on the basis of the formula given in Annexure X of the Principal Regulation.
